



Serving in Remote Areas

Every region in Australia needs a police service and there are many benefits of serving in remote areas. Officers working these northern or western regions enjoy more recreation leave annually as well as attractive incentive and isolated locality allowances.

Travel concessions are issued to officers serving in isolated locations, which includes one return airfare per year for themselves, their spouse and/or dependent children as well as one return airfare to Brisbane or equivalent fares to any other centre within Queensland.

One or two officer station allowance is payable to officers employed at one and two

officer stations and is paid at a rate of 35% of an eligible employees fortnightly pay point. Incentive and locality allowances are not affected by the payment of a one or two officer station allowance. Police housing may also be available at a small cost in some areas.
