Thank you for your interest in a career in the Queensland Police Service.

The Queensland Police Service is committed to a program for the recruitment and training of experienced police officers from other Australian police services. The program provides the opportunity for current serving officers and former officers to continue a police career in Queensland. Traditionally there are intakes in January, May and September of each year.

Overseas officers may take advantage of this program but only where they meet the Immigration requirements of entry to Australia. Further information can be obtained from the Information Brochure.

Applications can take anywhere from two to six months to process, depending on the individual applicants particulars and circumstances which in turn determines the length of time required to complete all stages of the selection process. POLICE RECRUITING will notify applicants of their progress throughout this period.

- Assistance with relocation expenses (up to \$2,000)
- Constable's salary paid from commencement of conversion course
- On appointment as a Constable, salary up to \$66,139 pa with allowances
- Eligibility to be qualified for Senior Constable within 12 months of appointment as a Constable
- Senior Constable salary from \$70,030 pa to \$83,999 pa with allowances
- Opportunity to serve in Brisbane and tropical centres such as Cairns
- Promotion from Senior Constable to higher ranks based upon merit.
