2. Details of the relevant interest, relevant power or relevant position each associate holds or will hold or may be entitled to exercise.

PROOF OF IDENTITY

If you are the holder of a current Weapons Act licence of another type, you are not required to complete another Form 30 Proof of Identity Declaration or supply recent photograph UNLESS—
1. A period of not more than 3 years has elapsed since you provided proof of identity and photographs; OR
2. The current licence card does not reflect an accurate likeness of you (e.g. have you grown or removed a beard since the issue of the licence card?)

**COURSE IN SAFETY TRAINING FOR WEAPONS**

- 1. Provide details of any current weapons licence held; OR
- 2. Provide proof of the successful completion of an approved course in safety training for weapons—a 'Statement of Attainment' issued within the last twelve months, detailing the date the certificate was awarded, the categories of the weapons in which you have been deemed competent, and the name of the registered training provider.
