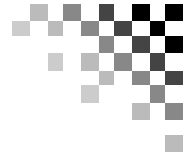

CONFIRMATION OF FIREARMS BROUGHT INTO AUSTRALIA**How to complete Part 2**

- For combination firearms, both calibres must be supplied, separated by a slash. Eg. "12G/22"
- A correct serial number, appropriate to the make and model of the firearm, must be supplied. (Take care to avoid part numbers or product numbers on grips etc. INVALID NUMBERS WILL DELAY YOUR APPLICATION. If in doubt, seek assistance from an authorised firearms identifier).

Visitor Permits issued for the purposes of hunting or Safari trips, will only be recognised within the State/Territory of issue. If you intend to hunt interstate, you will need to obtain a permit for each State/Territory to be visited.
