



## VICTIM OF VEHICLE THEFT – CAR GIVEAWAY

The Queensland Police Service and the YMCA are working in partnership to deliver the U-Turn Program to give young people an opportunity to learn new skills and turn their lives around whilst reducing the impact of vehicle theft in the Queensland community. U-Turn is jointly funded by the Australian Government, National Crime Prevention Program and the National Motor Vehicle Theft Reduction Council.

At the core of U-Turn is a structured 10-week training course for young offenders (15 to 20 years old) and youth at risk of offending. It is based around an automotive workshop incorporating the best features of similar diversionary programs in Australia and the United Kingdom.

Part of the training involves restorative justice, whereby the young people restore donated cars, which can then be given to an individual or a family who have been the victim of a car theft resulting in hardship. Recipients for these restored cars will be chosen from the local community.

**Please note:** *These are not new cars, but they are roadworthy and good solid vehicles. As vehicles become available recipients will be selected by an independent panel.*
