

## Overseas Travel

During 2002–03, 49 members of the Service travelled overseas on 35 occasions of official business or to attend professional development. On 28 occasions, the costs of travel were fully or partially met by external agencies.

In response to the Bali bombing incident, 15 specialised Service personnel travelled to Bali to assist local authorities identify victims of the terrorist attack. The costs of travel were met by the Australian Federal Police.
