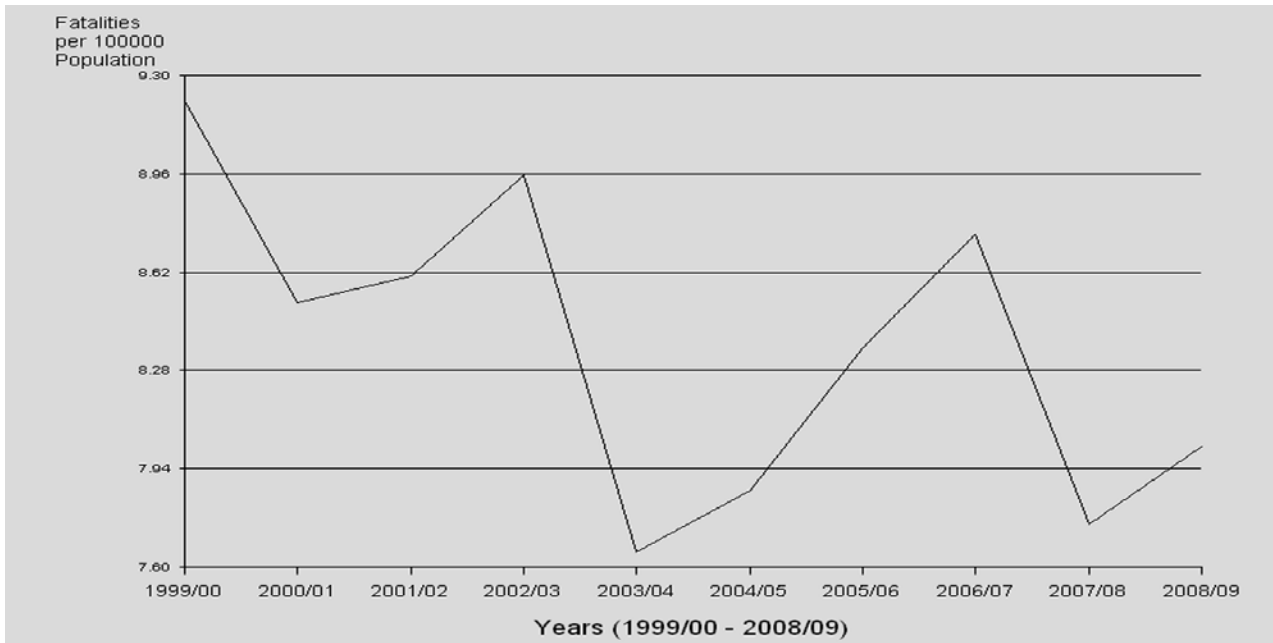
This section contains information relating to traffic crashes, speed, red light camera notices and random breath tests within Queensland.

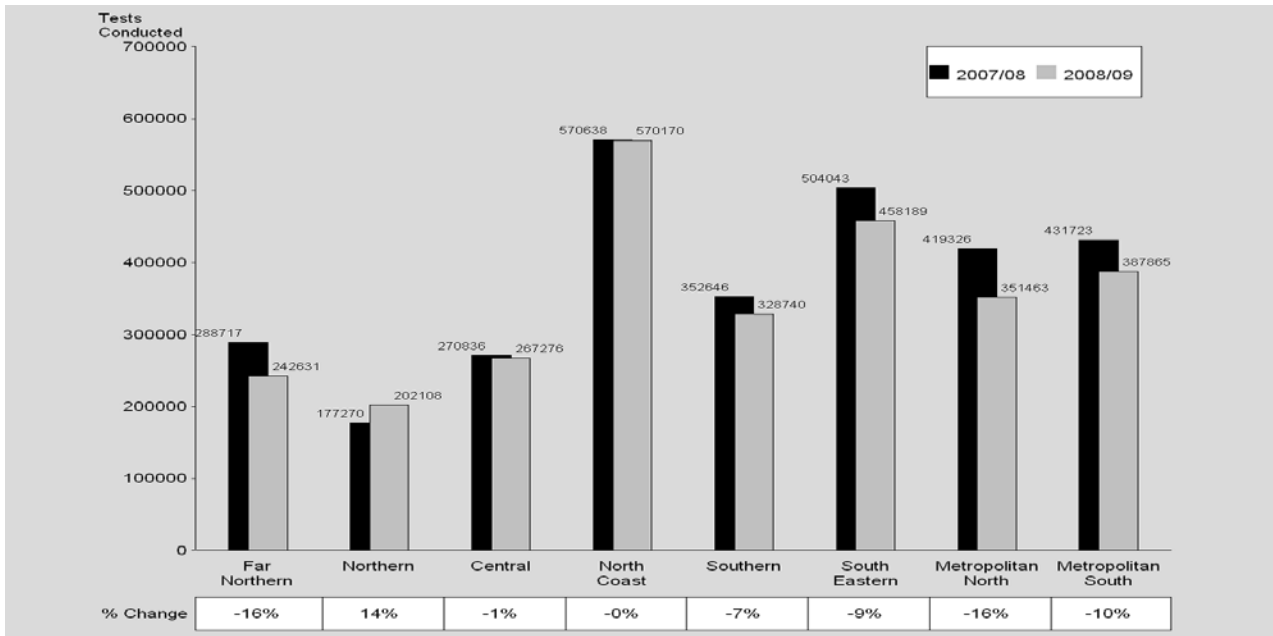
Road Fatalities - Queensland



Queensland's road fatality rate for the 2008/09 financial year was 8 fatalities per 100,000 persons. Queensland recorded 3% increase in the rate per 100,000 persons when compared with

the previous year. The lowest recorded road fatality rate for Queensland was 7.7 during the 2003/04 financial year, and the highest was 32.1 during the 1970/71 financial year.

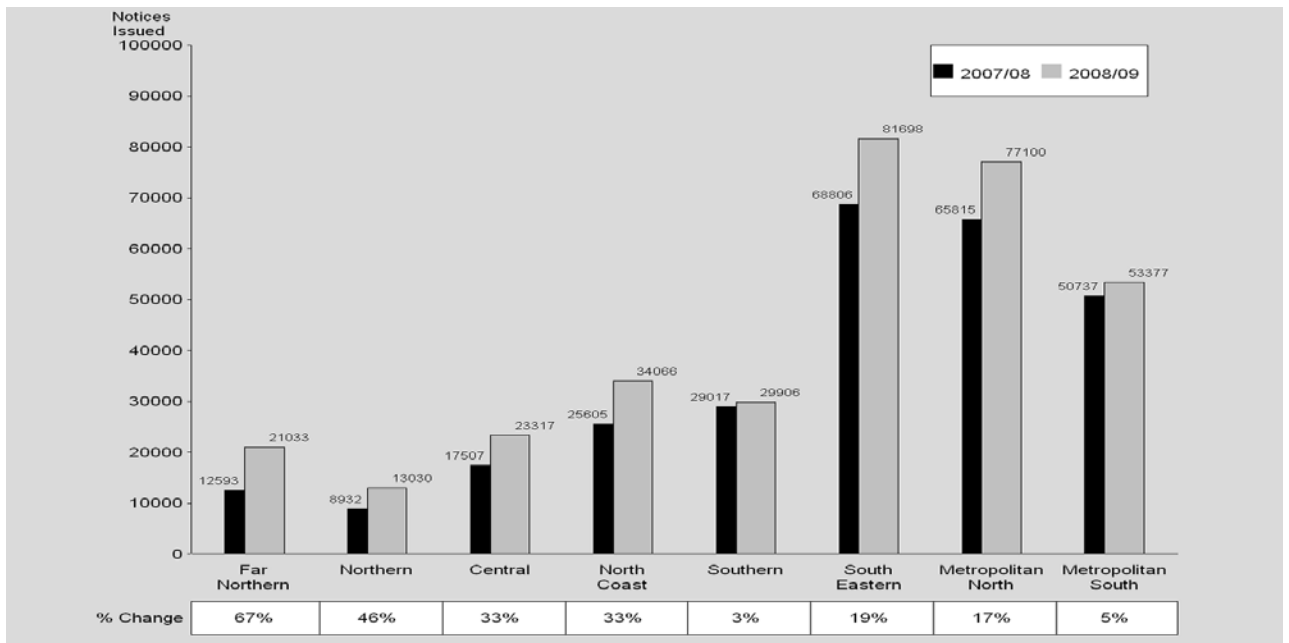
Random Breath Tests - Queensland by Region^{^*}
