

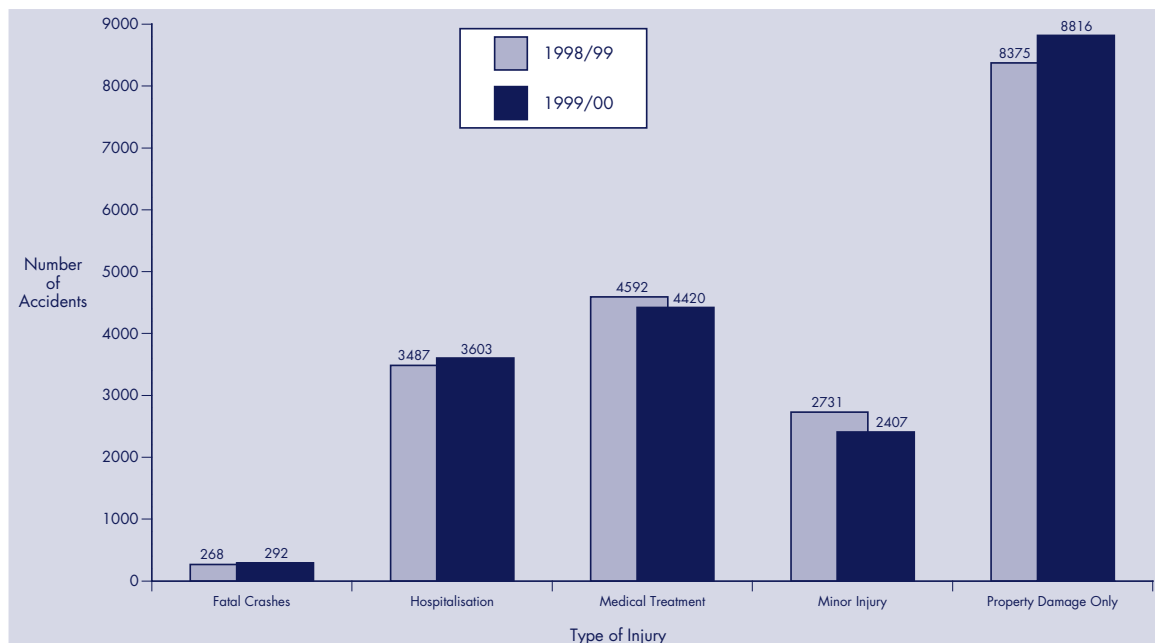
# Traffic

This section contains information relating to traffic accidents, speed and red light notices and random breath tests within Queensland.

All random breath test data were provided by the State Traffic Support Group of the Queensland Police Service and is current as at 7 August 2000. All traffic accident data were provided by the Strategy Branch of the Land Transport and Safety Division of the Queensland Department of Transport and is current as at 27 July 2000.

District statistics for Metropolitan North Region have been presented according to the former Statistical Districts of Brisbane Central and North Brisbane rather than the eight new statistical districts created on 1 July, 1996, as information is not available according to these new boundaries.

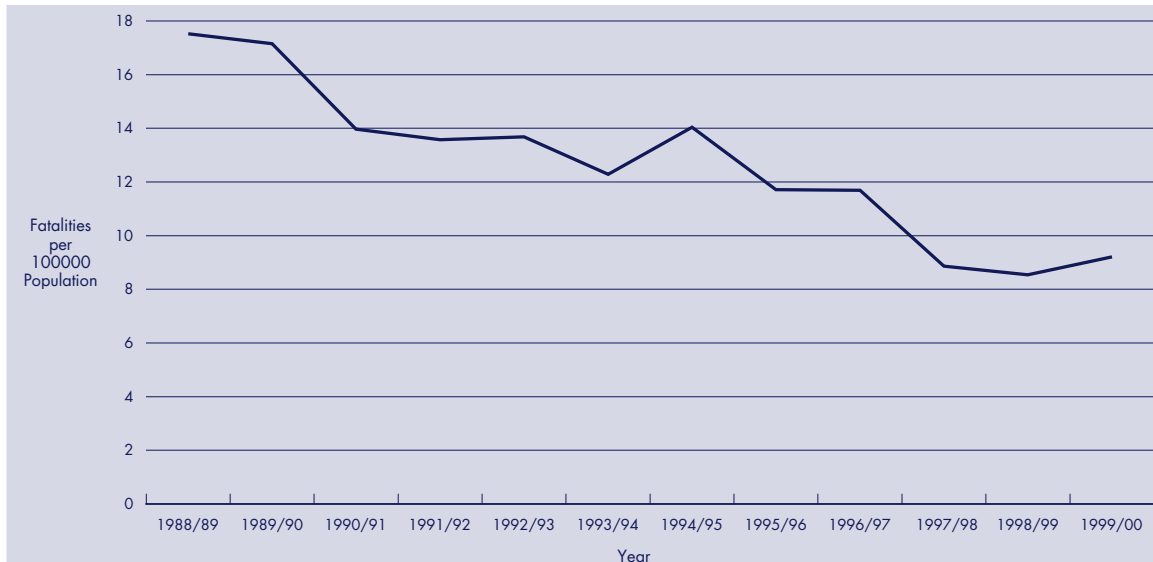

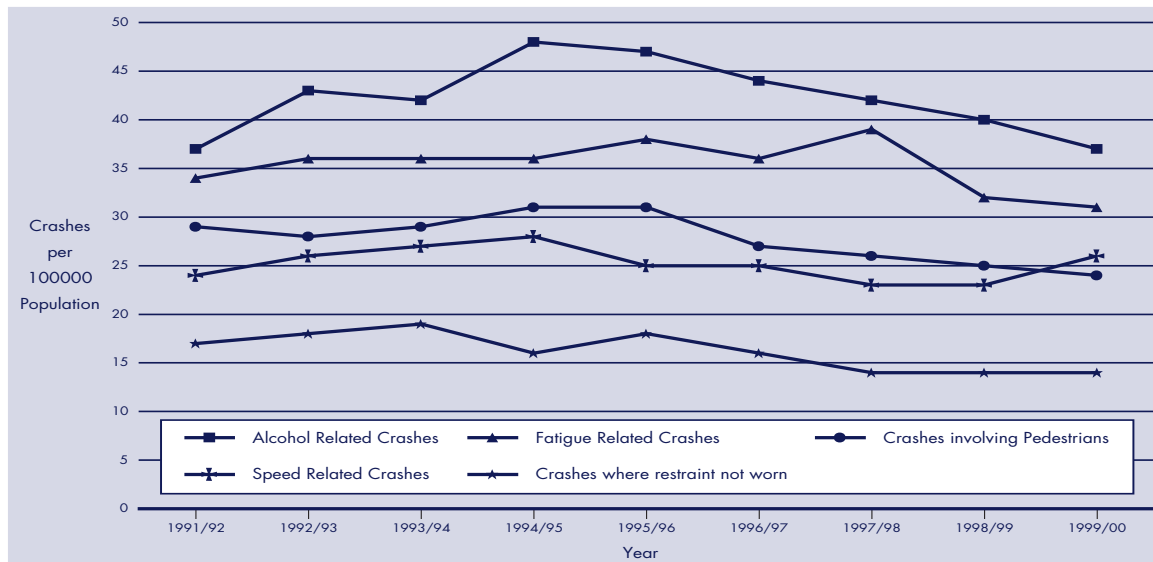

## Crashes: Fatal Four & Pedestrians - Queensland\* ^

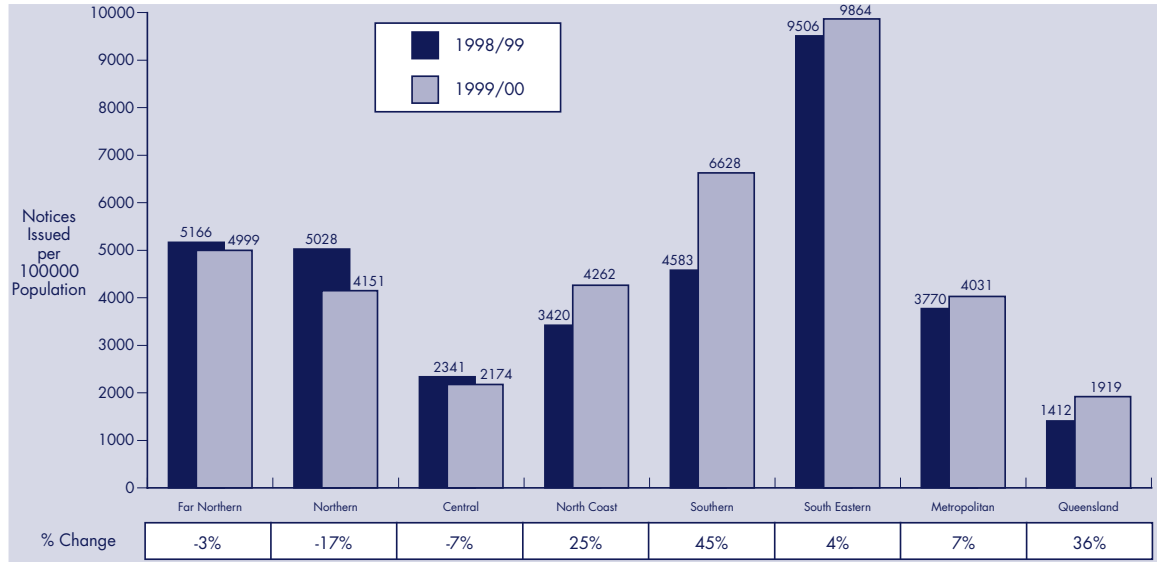

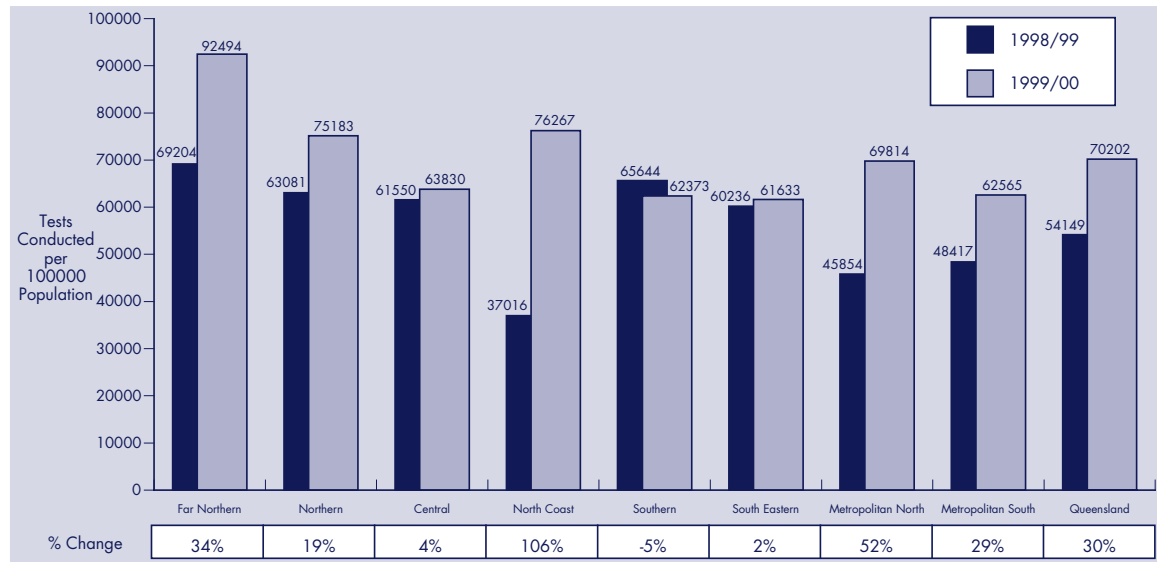
