

Traffic

This section contains information relating to traffic accidents, speed and red light notices and random breath tests within Queensland.

All random breath test data were provided by the State Traffic Support Group of the Queensland Police Service and is current as at 8 August 2002. All traffic accident data were provided by the Road Use Data Analysis Branch of the Land Transport and Safety Division of the Queensland Department of Transport and is current as at 29 July 2002.

District statistics for Metropolitan North Region have been presented according to the former Statistical Districts of Brisbane Central and North Brisbane rather than the eight new statistical districts created on 1 July, 1996, and the two new districts created on the 1 January, 2001, as

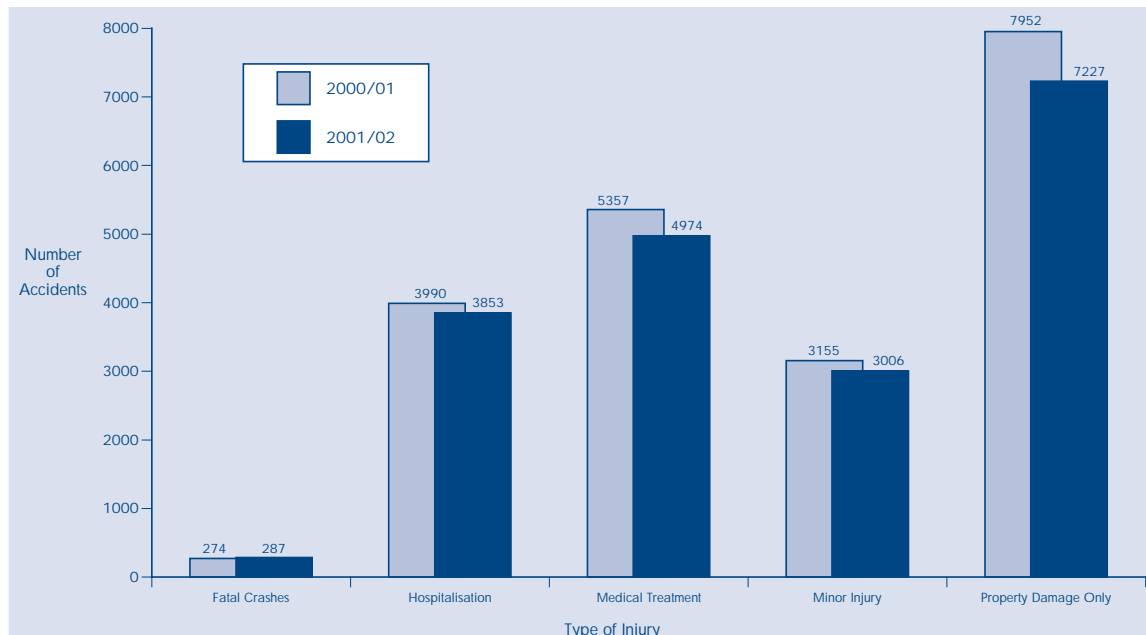
information is not available according to these new boundaries.

It should be noted that, to qualify as valid, crashes must meet the following criteria:

- the crash occurs on a public road;
- a person is injured, or the value of the property damage is:
 - a. \$2500 to property other than vehicles (after 1 December 1999)
 - b. \$2500 damage to vehicle and property (after 1 December 1991 & prior to 1 December 1999)
 - c. value of property damage is greater than \$1000 (prior to December 1991)
- at least one vehicle was towed away.

Crashes resulting from medical conditions or deliberate acts are excluded.

* Please note information held in the Road Crash Database on events occurring within the last twelve months are considered preliminary as investigations into crashes can take up to one year to finalise.

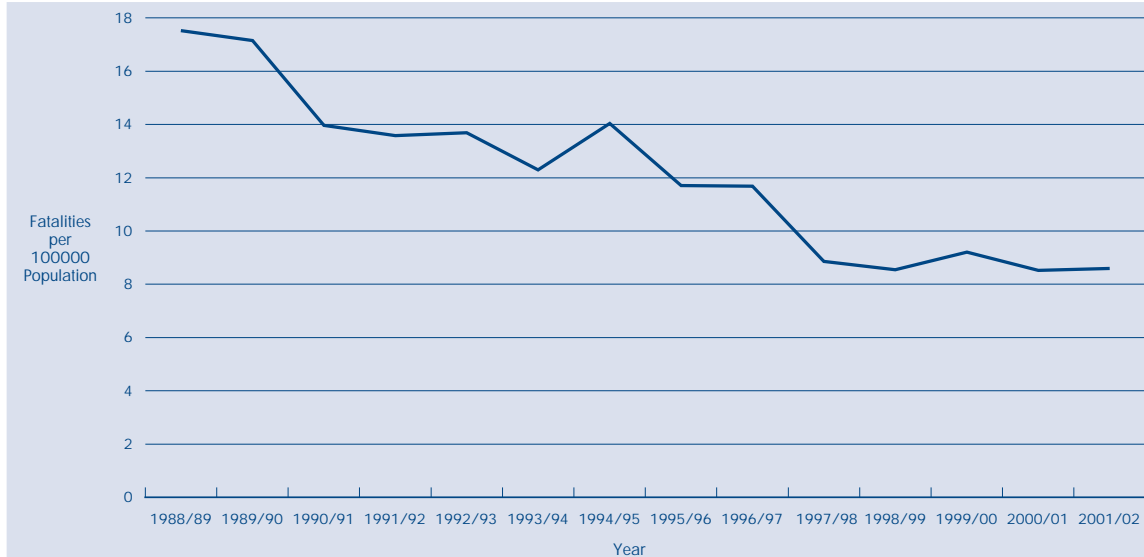

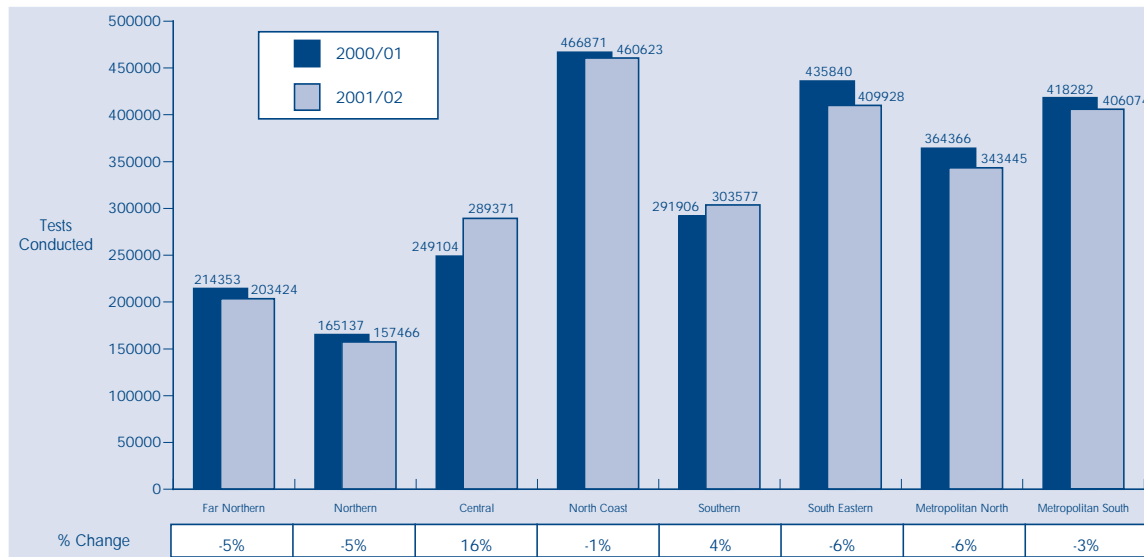

Rate of Road Fatalities - Queensland

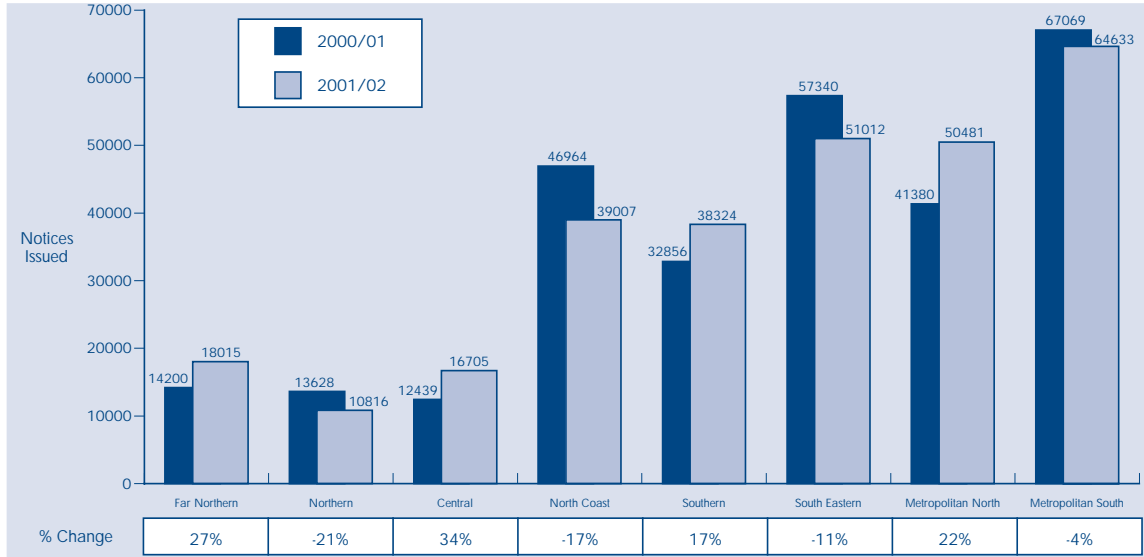


Random Breath Tests by Region - Queensland
