Divisional Profile: The Jimboomba Division is approximately 600 square kilometres in size and is situated between Browns Plains and Beaudesert. It is located within the Logan City Council shire. The division also manages the activities of a two officer Neighbourhood Police Beat, situated at Logan Village. The population of Jimboomba is estimated at 54,040 (as of 2016) with an annual growth rate of approximately 15%.

The Mt. Lindesay Highway runs through the division (north/south) and is a major interstate transport link, providing access through the area to and from Brisbane and New South Wales. Teviot and Waterford-Tamborine Roads are also key arterial through-fares now servicing the southern Brisbane area.

Opening hours: The station operates on a 24 hour basis, however the counter is only open from 8am to 4pm each weekday

Other Squads: A unit from the Logan Road Policing Command works from the station, undertaking road policing activities in the Logan South Western divisions. In addition the station is home to a unit from the Logan District Child Protection and Investigation Unit.
