J1822-26112022 refers. Offence occurred as per the MO. SM476 attended scene as per detail from Police comms. Upon arrival Police sighted QLD registration XB59BA alight from the rear cabin. This truck is owned by Carters Transport. Multiple QFES on scene along with QAS and civilians. This address is a large industrial shed premises with multiple businesses in the space. Involved business is Peter Carter Transport trading as Carters Transport and Wards Transport. Both business have the address of 69 Shettleston St Rocklea. Both businesses are a transport company travelling over QLD. Police observed vehicle,

rear of the trucks alight. The rear of these trucks backed onto the fence line of Carters Transport and there was a set of wooden pallets stacked high at this fence line, these had perished. Above trucks and pallets are on the fenceline of Wards Transport. Police TUW all persons on scene - INF Sch4p4(6) version. He advised that he saw smoke coming from over the other side of the large industrial shed. He drove around and saw no persons in the vacinity with the from wire gate locked and a fire on the fenceline which later spread to the nearby parked trucks. QFES advised it appeared the fire originated from pallets and then spread to involved vehicle. QFES having fire investigator attend scene to continue investigation to ensure fire was not suspicious and to attempt to discover the origin and ignition source. The weather was a dry and windy 35 degree sunny day. NIL suspects or CCTV. SOC not required. DDO MATERNE contacted and DDO advised he would notify UMG CIB. Nil further leads to investigate unless further information is obtained from the QFRS fire investigator. .

> Attended scene and briefed by DDO MATERNE. Walk through of scene conducted with SOC 4017511 and QFES Fire Investigator Sch4p4(6) examined scene and advised that the fire likely originated from pallets containing wood/rubber on fence line of Unit 3 and then spread to the involved vehicles. Sch4p4(6) identified nil source of combustion or indications that the fire had been deliberately lit. Noted that weather conditions were very hot (35 degrees) with high winds. TUW Sch4p4(6) who provided consent for Crime Scene (captured on DSC AHERN Notebook). Damaged vehicles are insured. Examinations concluded and crime scene closed 1630hrs. Unable to determine whether fire was suspicious at this stage - for further investigation. Nil damage to buildings.

- CCTV cameras located on exterior and interior of premises however Sch4p4(6) does not have access to the footage as he only recently moved into premises and doesn't know the password. Contacted previous owner, who will make enquiries re the password and advise UMG CIB.

#### Narrative:

On 26/11/2022, Forensic Officer 4017511 ARNOLD - CAL BR SBA SOC conducted a forensic examination at 44 SHETTLESTON ST ROCKLEA. Forensic Register Number FR2170347 refers.

A White UD unknown Light Truck etc. OTH Reg #XB59BA was examined.

TUW QFRS Fire investigator Sch4p4(6) , DDO MATERNE and UMG CIB GEMMELL/AHERN in relation to a number of vehicles damaged as a result of a fire. The offence location is a large industrial logistics hub used for the storage and loading of supply trucks. The front parking area is separated into two areas (units 2 and 3 with a six foot high chain wire fence. Informant Sch4p4(6) had his UD brand truck (XB59BA) located with pallets of paper cups, milk and baby gates. The truck was parked with its back to the middle fence in unit 2. A number of empty wooden pallets were situated behind the truck. On the opposite side of the fence (unit 3) had miscellaneous items including pallets with metal cages containing wood and plastic water containers. There is no electricity to this area.

At approximately 1300hrs workers from a neighbouring building have observed a fire in the refuse pile along the fence line. Strong winds at the time have caused the pallets behind the truck to ignite and the rear of the truck to become engulfed. Heat damage has been caused to two truck trailers and one fruck parked in unit 3. The informant reports that the yard of unit three houses a number of different logistics company with multiple workers coming and going at various times. No persons were seen in the area of origin at the time and no work was going on in that area (welding etc). It is unknown if any of the trucks or trailers parked in that area had been in use prior to the fire occurring. There is no CCTV of that area. No fuel or other flammable substances are reportedly stored in that area. Sch4p4 (6) states that fire patterns indicate that the fire started within the refuse pile beside the fence in the yard of unit three, however the cause of ignition is not determined.
