Strategic Directorate

The Directorate works in partnership with disaster management stakeholders to enable a high standard of disaster management policy and planning across the sector. The team contributes to community safety through support to partner agencies, has a key focus on lessons and continuous improvement and promotes leading practice disaster management strategic policy, planning and doctrine.

Capability, Development and Assurance

The group has a key focus on building, and maintaining capability across Queensland's Disaster and Emergency Management sector. By collaborating with partners, the group ensures emerging challenges are addressed, further strengthening the disaster management arrangements. With a strong focus on capability building, training, and exercise management, the group continues to play a key role in supporting the sector's ongoing development and readiness.

Disaster Operations

This operations team, which includes the Watch Desk is committed to adopting and implementing innovative best practices to enhance our preparedness, response, and support for our disaster and emergency partners.

The Public Information and Warnings Unit is vital to supporting disaster operations through developing, coordinating, and disseminating information to both the public and incident management responders - ensuring Queenslander's safety is a priority during disasters.

State Disaster Coordination Centre

The State Disaster Coordination Centre (SDCC) is an operational centre located within the Queensland Emergency Services Complex at Kedron. The Centre enables staff from government and non-government agenies to work collaboratively to support communities in disasters and emergencies, as well as support decision making for the Queensland Disater Management Committee.
