A **service user** is anyone who has contact with the Queensland Police Service. This can include:


- people who have done something wrong.

We will make sure our digital places are easy to use.




We will make sure we have buildings that are accessible for you to use.

Make sure they are inclusive and accessible for people with disability.




We will make sure people with disability are safe and supported when dealing with domestic and family violence.

Human Rights

Human rights are things that everyone should have.





- the right to apply for work in government.
- the police have to tell you what they think you did and what you have been charged with – in language you understand.

We will make sure that we respect your human rights.

Co-design

Co-design means talking to a lot of people to make decisions. This includes talking to people with disability.

We will use co-design to make sure that people with disability help make decisions about things that affect them.
