



Take on the role of a trainee Queensland Police Scenes of Crime Officer (SOCO)

OBJECTIVE: You are a trainee Queensland Police Scenes of Crime Officer (SOCO). You have entered the scene of a murder and it is your job to use the tools at your disposal to gather evidence, compile a report, and discover who committed the crime. Take your time and read the **USER GUIDE**. Think carefully about the crime scene, the evidence presented and the ways in which you can collect it. Good photographs and careful thought about what you collect and how you have it analysed will earn you more points. The higher your score, the more likely you will pass the test and become a qualified SOCO.

STEP 1

Download the QPM Forensics AR app

STEP 2

OPEN THE APP and take the time to read the **USER GUIDE**

These 8 tips will help you navigate the app successfully. Museum staff are on hand to give assistance if required.

STEP 3

Collect the evidence using the icons depicted

CAMERA - to photograph each piece of evidence
DNA TEST KIT - to take a DNA swab
FINGERPRINT - to collect latent fingerprints
EVIDENCE BAG - collect the evidence for later analysis



STEP 4

Touch View Evidence



STEP 5

Test the evidence

All the evidence you collected can be sent away for testing. Touch the microscope button for forensic testing. When the button changes to light blue touch it again to read the results.*

*You must review the testing results to be able to move on to Step 6.

Choose to include (Tick) or ignore (Down Arrow) evidence based on the testing results.



STEP 6

Touch View Facts

This lists the Facts associated with the evidence you found. Select the facts you think will be important to highlight in the final report.



STEP 7

Touch Next

Order the evidence neatly and methodically and submit your Final Report

HINT: Move the most important facts at the top of the list with the arrows, use the X to delete the facts that will not useful to the case



STEP 8

Touch Submit Report

The App will calculate your score from what facts were or were not included.



YOUR FINAL SCORE

The higher your score, the more likely you will pass the test and become a qualified SOCO.

000-150 Pay more attention and try again

151-300 Good job, have another go

301-450 Great work, concentrate on the accuracy of your Final Report

450-600 Excellent, you will make a great SOCO
