Regulatory proposals where no RIA is required	<p>The regulatory proposal replaces and modernises the <i>Police Powers and Responsibilities 2012</i> in substantially the same form with only minor amendments to existing provisions to comply with modern drafting practices and removal of some obsolete provisions. There have been no policy changes resulting from the remake.</p> <p>The QPS is of the view that the entirety of the <i>Police Powers and Responsibilities Regulation 2026</i> deals with police powers and administration and therefore no regulatory impact analysis is required under the <i>Queensland Government Better Regulation Policy</i>.</p>
