

Proposal type	Details
Regulatory proposals where no RIA is required	<p>Section 808D of the <i>Police Powers and Responsibilities Act 2000</i> (PPRA) provides that a regulation may prescribe an area of the State to be a 'Designated Business and Community Precinct' (DBCP) if the Minister is satisfied there is a need to enhance public safety or public amenity, reduce anti-social behaviour, or reduce or prevent the disruption of businesses within that area.</p> <p>A police officer in a DBCP may:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> require a person to submit to the use of a hand held scanner under section 39BA of the PPRA; require a person to state the person's name and address under section 40 of the PPRA; give a person or group of persons a move on direction under section 48 of the PPRA; and give particular persons a police banning notice under section 602C of the PPRA. <p>The <i>Police Powers and Responsibilities (Maryborough Designated Business and Community Precinct) Amendment Regulation 2026</i> (the Amendment Regulation) will amend the <i>Police Powers and Responsibilities Regulation 2026</i> by prescribing the area and boundary of a DBCP in Maryborough.</p> <p>The QPS has identified that no regulatory impact analysis is required under the <i>Queensland Government Better Regulation Policy</i>, as the Amendment Regulation is a regulatory proposal that relates to police powers and administration, and is machinery in nature.</p>
